The most exciting news since the last newsletter is the adoption of two books as required text for two courses at Excelsior College. The two classes deal with the theme of Diaspora. The courses both deal with dispersed groups of individuals. One course is focused on teachers, the other is a general liberal studies graduate level class. In both cases the inclusion of the book is to provide methods to build cultural understanding and to provide tools that can be used in classrooms and community group situations. The courses are funded by a Ford Foundation grant. The first course will be offered in October, and the other in March 2008.
